Council hearings on appeals are subject to the ex parte communication restrictions of the California Administrative Procedures Act (Gov. Code § 11430.10 et seq.). An ex parte communication is a "communication, direct or indirect, regarding any issue in the proceeding, to the [Council or Council member or Council staff] from an employee or representative of any agency that is a party or from an interested person outside the agency, without notice and opportunity for all parties to participate in the communication." Ex parte communications regarding this certification of consistency or the appeal are prohibited. This restriction applies from the date that any appeals are filed to the date that the Council reaches a final decision on the appeals.
